Admission Rules :

- ◆ Admission is open to both boys and girls based on merit. Application for admission shall be made on the prescribed form attached with the prospectus. This is provided from the school office.
- ◆ All students applying for admission are subjected to an interview and test. For admission the child should have completed 3½ years of age on first of July of the year for admission.
- ◆ Admission age for other classes will be counted accordingly. Students seeking admission to class II and above have to produce T.C. and Progress Report from the school he/she last attended.
- ◆ Interview of parents shall be taken before the admissions are confirmed.
- ◆ Photocopy of the Birth Certificate should be attached with the application form.
- ◆ Admissions are given on the basis of priority of registration and the result in the admission test and interview. The standard of the admission test is of the level of the Annual Examination of the class preceding to which admission is sought.
- ◆ Admission will be confirmed when all the above formalities are filled up along with the remittance of the first installment of fees (April fee) according to the school fee structure for which you will get the information from the school office.

Special Note :

Admission fee once remitted will not be refunded or adjusted. The school authorities reserve the right to grant or reject admission without assigning any reason.

Laboratories :

The school has well equipped science laboratories with full safety measures and all necessary apparatus for biology chemistry and physics. Labs are equipped with adequate facilities and equipments for conducting experiments under the able guidance of teachers and lab incharges. The school also houses mathematics lab where students are introduced to an all together different realm of designing building of graphics and cutting and fixing of puzzles to prove many a mathematical equation.

Computer Education :

This is the age of Hi-tech and Information technology revolution. A person of the new millennium without the computer literacy will be at a disadvantage. So we have introduced computer course from class III onwards as a compulsory training in the curriculum. By the time the student passes out of the Higher Secondary level he/she will be versed in computer languages and programming. The school is well equipped with computer lab.

Library-Cum-Reading room :

The school library and reading room help the students to augment their quest for knowledge. Library is stocked with a large number of books covering a wide range of subject, which will develop Inquisitiveness. Special Period(s) per week for each class are allotted so that the children may spend their time fruitfully in reading books, newspapers etc.

Conveyance Facility :

To relieve the parents tension for the safe conveyance of their children we have introduced our own school buses on all the major routes, at a reasonable fare. This facility is optional to the students. Though door to door service is not practical, care is taken to link all leading suburbs of the city. The authority to change, cancel or introduce various bus stops is reserved with the school management.

Fee Payment :

Tuition Fees are levied in 10 equal installments from April to March. Scheduled date for payment of tuition fee is on or before 10th of every month. A fine of Rs. 1/- per day is chargeable if the fee is not paid on the specified date. Failure of remittance of fee with fine before 26th of each month will result in the removal of the name of the student from the school register.

Then Re-admission will be only by the discretion of the school authorities with a Re-admission fees of Rs. 250/-.

Interact Club

German language classes

This Holistic approach enables our student to be well prepared for the globally networked society of knowledge that awaits them. At the end of course students receive certificate.

NCC

The School has an independent unit of NCC. NCC is an integral part of curriculum at school. NCC parade is held twice a week for the students, followed by refreshments. All candidates are given training as a part of NCC activities.

The NCC provides exposure to the candidates in a wide range of activities with the distinct emphasis on social services discipline and adventure training. The NCC is open to all regular students of school and on a voluntary basis

Scouting and Guiding

Scouting and guiding is an international movement- intends to inculcate the young boys and girls a spirit of loyalty, Patriotism and thoughtfulness for others. MTHSS focuses to train the students to face the challenges in life. Annual Scouts and guide camps are held where in students go outside the school and learn to give in a group getting accustomed to the prevailing environment.

They learn cooperation, camaraderie, group dynamics sportsmanship and some life skills to live peacefully in any situation. campfires and living in tents add up to their fun.



Karate and Yoga

Martial-Arts focuses on the body and the mind. The school have a well trained Karate and Yoga training facility which is important for the growth of children, because it promotes health and mind balance throughout the life.
